

Green Coke

Green Coke, produced in UP II Dumai Refinery, is produced from solid carbon substance utilizing Delayed Cooking Unit, which is able to be transferred from short residue to Green Coke.

Green Coke has heavier fraction compared to fuel oil, therefore, their calorific equivalent/rate is lower than fuel oil, viz around 7.500 – 8.500 K.cal/Kg. However, Green Cokes in term of calorific value, has higher calorie than coal does, that is only 5000 - 6000 K.cal/Kg.

Green Coke is distributed in bulk form.

Special Features

1. Having higher calorific value (7.500 - 8.500 K.cal/Kg) compared to coal (5000 - 6000 K.cal/Kg)
2. Containing low ash value.
